December Message from Driver Education Department:

Behind-the-Wheel Driver Training is offered year round at the Carbon County Intermediate Unit # 21. Driving sessions take place after the school day, Saturdays, Sundays & Holidays as well as during the summer months. The weather is always a consideration for the safety of the student drivers. Winter weather being unpredictable as it is, driving sessions may be cancelled due to the weather.

- If the school day is cancelled due to weather any student who scheduled a driving session that day will be contact by the instructor if the driving session is cancelled.
- During the school day, if weather causes an early dismissal or the cancellation of after school activities any student who scheduled a driving session that afternoon will be contact by the instructor if the session is cancelled.
- If the weather conditions effect Saturday, Sunday, or Holiday driving sessions who any student scheduled for a driving session those days will be contact by the instructor if the session is cancelled

When a student's lesson is canceled due to the weather, rescheduling for that session will be the student's responsibility.

Reminder on Seat Belt Safety (flying elephant).....

While you are traveling over the December holiday, make sure everyone, from infants to grandparents, is properly restrained. In a 30 mile per hour crash, an unrestrained adult is thrown with a force of 3½ tons – about the weight of an elephant. Click It or Ticket and avoid taking a flying elephant along for the ride.
