

## **PHS Monthly News Letter item January Message from Driver Education Department:**

The Driver Education Program offers students the opportunity to take their **DRIVERS LICENSE TEST** at Parkland High School. This test replaces the need to test with the Pennsylvania Department of Motor Vehicles for a junior license. To qualify for this license test a student must complete all the behind-the-wheel driving lessons and complete or be enrolled for the Driver Education classroom theory instruction.

Students taking the driving test after school or on Saturdays should report to room D133. Students will need to bring with them their learner's permit and a DL-180C form. Parents must sign this form, in the presence of a notary or one of the certified test instructors.

**To qualify for the Drivers Education Certification, students must successfully complete a minimum of 30 classroom hours and completion of the behind-the-wheel program.**

The fee for the behind- the-wheel program is \$50.00. Many insurance companies recognize these education programs by granting a “**Drivers Education Insurance Discount**” to young drivers who complete both the classroom and behind-the-wheel programs. At the conclusion of both programs a Drivers Education Certificate will be issued to the student

All sign-up sheets for the students to participate in the Driving Training program are located in the Guidance office's Career and Resource Center. Please read and neatly sign your name on the appropriate clipboard.
